Before the home visit, corporate volunteers attended a 30-minute volunteer training at the Shine Skills Centre in Pok Fu Lam. Social workers shared useful and practical information, including the know-how for home visit and communication skills. Thereafter, volunteers were divided into eight teams and started the home visit with Christmas gift packs.


