### **Hong Kong Life collaborates with The Project Futurus to Host “Soft Meal Workshop and Outreach Action” Caring for the Elderly and Building an Inclusive and Compassionate Community**

Hong Kong, 13 November 2025 — Hong Kong Life Insurance Limited (“Hong Kong Life”) is committed to caring for the community through active collaboration with various social service organizations to organize a wide range of volunteer activities, and encouraging staff participation. These efforts aim to extend compassion to the underprivileged in the community, and work together to foster a caring and inclusive society.

Recently, Hong Kong Life has joined hands with the elderly-focused social enterprise The Project Futurus to host a “Soft Meal Workshop and Outreach Action” (“the Event”), inviting members of the Hong Kong Life volunteer team and their families and friends to take part. The Event aims to enhance awareness about swallowing difficulties and the benefits of soft meals for elderly individuals affected by such conditions. It also sought to cultivate empathy among participants and deepen their understanding of elderly care needs.

Under the guidance of professional instructors, participants learned how to prepare soft dim sum such as siu mai and har gow, explored their nutritional value, and enjoyed tasting their own creations. Following the workshop, participants delivered chef-prepared dim sum meal boxes to the Yan Chai Nursing Home nearby, participants visited elderly residents with swallowing difficulties, shared creative snacks, and engaged in warm conversations, helping the elderly rediscover the joy of eating and feel the warmth of people connection.

Hong Kong Life has consistently partnered with social service organizations to organize volunteer activities that respond to social needs and bring positive energy to the community. It is delighted that this Event provided our staff with a valuable learning opportunity. It is not only to understand the dietary needs of individuals with swallowing difficulties, but also to acquire soft meal preparation skills. It is hoped that participants will share what they have learned with their families and friends. At the same time, through the outreach visit, participants were able to personally deliver fresh dim sum meal boxes to the elderly, offering heartfelt care through meaningful interaction and fostering a culture of compassion and inclusion in the society.
